Police arrest Daniel Clippard and Anthony Harrington, both African American, alleging they solicited sex acts from two white men. Prostitution charges were dropped, but Clippard continued to face charges for dressing as a woman, wearing when arrested: black pants, brown jacket, black and purple western shirt, ladies shoes, a wig and makeup. Clippard (D.C.) joined the ACLU of Eastern Missouri's case challenging the city's cross-dressing ordinance.
