[We agree, swearing] the awesome holy oath of our [masters Valentinian and] Valens, everlasting Augusti, [that we have received . . . ] and loaded into [our ships, from the produce of] the fortunate 11<sup>th</sup> new [indiction, or pure unadulterated grain,] unwetted and free of any fault . . .
