August 25, 1953 Emil J. Horesje, a pharmacist from Chicago, met several men for drinks at the Entre Nous bar. Horseje left the bar about midnight with two men, and walked towards Pine Street. Horesje was found hours later beaten to death in a parking lot. His face was so badly damaged police asked the Entre Nous bartender to identify his body. Further investigations by police revealed in his possessions a watch with a man's name engraved on it, a torn-up photo of an unidentified man, and an address book with names of St. Louisians.
