A privately run home / hospice for people with AIDS founded by Charles Baxter. Legal fight with city authorities for permission to open 1987-1988. Closed 1990 with Baxter reporting heavy emotional, financial, and physical exhaustion. Briefly after closing, the building was rented for an antiques store, then torn down in December 1990 and replaced with parking lot.
