Protest against St. Louis Mayor Schoemehl for his lack of attention to AIDS-related issues, April 22, 1991.

In the morning, ACT UP put up tombstones with slogans about HIV in flower planters (one of Schoemehl's programs was planting flowers) along Forest Park Blvd.

There were also banners hung up from crosswalks across US 40 / Interstate 64, and at the Forest Park Community College crosswalk and the crosswalk near Barnes Medical Center. The banners gave the current number of St. Louis AIDS deaths, and asked what action the Mayor would take.
