Additional Information:

Located at California and Shenandoah; sometimes listed as 2800 Shenandoah.

Listed as a restaurant in the 1946 city directory, as Albert Mallet liquors in 1952, as Milford Lougeau liquors in 1946-1957, and as Lorraine Schuman Tavern in 1958.

Community recollections indicate this became a lesbian bar sometime in the late 1950s or early 1960s.

"Betty's" or "Betty's California Bar" operated by Betty Glidden, who at least for a time lived in the building, circa 1965 – 1979.

"Sandy's California Bar" operated by Sandy Harvey, who at least for a time lived in building, circa 1976-1980.

Described in guidebooks as: 90% lesbian in Gaia's 1978, "girls and very popular" in Damron. Some guidebooks give the location as Shenandoah and Compton, however research indicates this was likely an error.
