Bars along Olive Street were frequented by predominantly white patrons in the 1950s and 1960s.

By the 1970s the Onyx was listed in Damron guidebooks as very popular, dancing, youth and college-aged crowd. *PrimeTime* 1977 described as "nice atmosphere, good crowd, predominantly black, especially in the evenings." Ciao! article about St. Louis bars listed as "little rough. Some hustlers. Some blacks."
